1. DEFINITIONS

(a) "Binary Code" means the machine-readable, executable code of a computer program.

(b) "Bona Fide Services" mean installation, support, maintenance or warranty services provided by You on a customer-by-customer basis for Modified or Unmodified Code.

(c) "Cobia Module" means any custom network, security or other software application of a third party or the Original Developer that is developed using the Software's application programming interface or API.

(d) "Code" means collectively the Unmodified Code the Modified Code and the Updater Code.

(e) "Consideration" means all forms of consideration, both direct and indirect, cash and non-cash, including but not limited to: money, goods (whether tangible or intangible), services, referrals, anything of value (such as foregoing a legal right or claim), or an offer or promise of any of the foregoing.

(f) "Contribution Agreement" means the StillSecure Community Contribution Agreement located at <http://cobia.stillsecure.com/contributionagreement/>.

(g) "Contributor" means each Entity that creates, develops or contributes to the creation or development of Modified Code and agrees to be legally bound by the Contribution Agreement.

(h) "Distribute" means to sell, offer for download, distribute, license, lease, disclose, disseminate, sublicense or otherwise copy or transfer to any third party Entity other than You or your subsidiaries. ■

(i) "Entity" means any individual, corporation or any other legal entity.

(j)“Intellectual Property Right” means all intellectual property and proprietary rights throughout the world now existing and subsequently created except trademark rights, and any applications or registrations relating to such rights, including, without limitation, all trade secrets, patents, copyrights, moral rights, database rights and other analogous rights throughout the world.

(k)“License” means this StillSecure Community License (version 1.0).

(l)“Modified Code” means any change, addition, deletion or modification made by You to the Unmodified Code or previously Modified Code. The term “Modified Code” does not include any Cobia Module.

(m)“Original Developer” means Latis Networks, Inc. (d.b.a. StillSecure).

(n)“Patent Claim” means any patent claim, now owned or acquired at a later date in any patent licensable by grantor.

(o)“Source Code” means the human readable form of a program or other work that is suitable for making modifications to it, including all modules it contains, plus any associated interface definition files, scripts used to control compilation and installation of executable code.

(p)“Unmodified Code” means the Source Code and Binary Code that is provided directly to You by the Original Developer under the terms of this License.

(q)“Updater Code” means the portion of code in the Unmodified Code or Modified Code that functions to automatically detect updates or upgrades for the Unmodified Code or Modified Code, and which is included in the file named, <filename.lib>.

(r)“You” means the Entity exercising rights under this License.

2. GRANT OF RIGHTS

(a)From Original Developer. Subject to the restrictions in Section 2 of this License, the Original Developer grants to You a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free license:

(i)under intellectual property rights owned or licensed by the Original Developer (other than patent or trademark), to use, reproduce, display, perform and modify (except as set forth in section 2(b)) the Unmodified Code solely for Your internal use.

(ii)under Patent Claims of the Original Developer necessarily infringed by the making or using of the Unmodified Code, to make, have made, use or practice any method embodied in the Unmodified Code. Notwithstanding this Section 2(a)(ii), no patent license is granted for Modified Code.

(iii)to Distribute Unmodified Code, but only if:

- A. You receive no Consideration for the Distribution of the Unmodified Code, except for Consideration received for Bona Fide Services You provide in connection with the Distribution;

- B. You do not embed, integrate, bundle or incorporate the Unmodified Code with any other product or good (whether tangible or intangible);
